

# Childhood Vaccine Program

## Eligibility for Publicly Funded Vaccines: A Guide for Providers

This document provides guidance on choosing the most appropriate patient eligibility status and Immunization Information System (IIS) coding for children and adults receiving publicly supplied vaccine.

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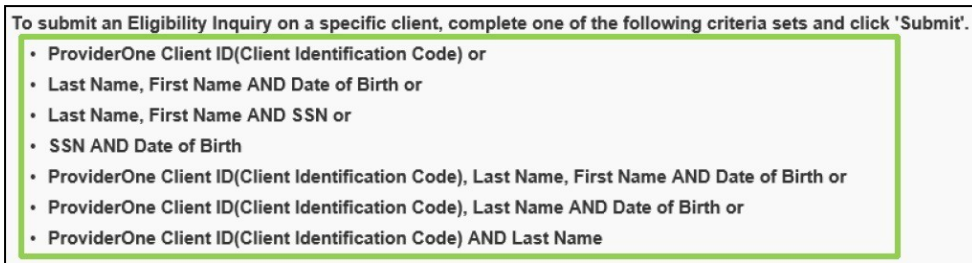
## Instructions for Accessing ProviderOne to Identify Eligibility Status of Apple Health Children

Coverage for Medicaid and CHIP enrolled children in Washington State falls under the umbrella of “Washington Apple Health for Kids”. Subgroups are not easily distinguished by name and have the same insurance card. Providers must log into ProviderOne to identify the correct eligibility category.

1. Log into ProviderOne and select the **Benefit Inquiry** link under the client section of the ProviderPortal.



2. Enter eligibility inquiry for the patient using any of the possible search criteria



3. Click Submit. Note: The inquiry start date will default to today’s date. Change this date if it is not the date of service.
4. ProviderOne displays the Client Benefit Level page. If your search was successful, the client’s benefit information is displayed.
5. Below the search criteria and patient demographic information, the page will display eligibility information.

6. Identify insurance type by their Recipient Aid Category (RAC) code and ACES Coverage Group code. See table below for CHIP/CHP RAC and ACES codes.
