Dear Washington Vaccine Association Health Insurers and Third-Party Administrators:

Effective January 1, 2023, Priorix™ and Vaxneuvance™ vaccines have been added to the [WVA's Vaccine Assessment Grid](#). See the billing changes below. These new vaccines are found on pages 1 and 2 in the [WVA Vaccine Assessment Grid](#).

Starting January 1, 2023, these vaccines will be billed by providers to commercial insurance payers and third-party administrators using the WVA's dosage-based assessment (DBA) process for patients under the age of 19. **As a payer, you will need to update your fee schedules with these codes and the WVA Assessment Amount for dates of service beginning January 1, 2023.**

Effective January 1, 2023, the following vaccines have been added to the WVA's Vaccine Assessment Grid:
