Dear Washington Vaccine Association Health Insurers and Third-Party Administrators:

Effective March 1, 2023, a new Rotarix® vaccine presentation (new NDC code) has been added to the [WVA's Vaccine Assessment Grid](#). See the NDC coding change below. This new vaccine presentation is found on page 2 of the [WVA Vaccine Assessment Grid](#).

Effective March 1, 2023, this vaccine presentation will be billed by providers to commercial insurance payers and third-party administrators using the WVA's dosage-based assessment (DBA) process for patients under the age of 19. **As a payer, if your payer transaction system differentiates NDCs for specific CPT codes, you will need to update your fee schedules to include this new NDC code. The CPT Code and WVA Assessment Amount remain the same as the prior NDC code.**

Effective March 1, 2023, the following vaccine NDC has been added to the WVA's Vaccine Assessment Grid:
