

COVID-19 Assessment Grid Updates

Bulletin Date: October 20, 2025

To: Washington Vaccine Association Health Insurers and Third-Party Administrators,

Please note that there has been an update to the 2025-26 WVA Assessment Grid (the "Grid") regarding COVID-19 vaccines. An additional COVID-19 vaccine for $\underline{\text{Nuvaxovid}}^{\text{TM}}$ has been added to the Grid since last week's notification of October 9, 2025. It should be added to payer and provider fee schedules.

Effective for dates of services between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026, COVID-19 vaccine NDCs have been updated in the 2025-26 WVA <u>Vaccine Assessment Grid</u> (the "Grid").

Reminders:

- The current WVA <u>Vaccine Assessment Grid</u> is in effect between July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, and it is posted to the WVA's website in both PDF and Excel format.
- The *Grid* lists vaccines and their corresponding CPT codes that are part of the dosage-based assessment (DBA) process for providers, health insurance carriers, and third-party administrators (TPAs). In effect, the *Grid* is the equivalent to a fee schedule. Providers are required to submit the DBA at the *Grid* amount, and health insurance carriers and TPAs are required to remit the <u>full amount</u> to the WVA.
- The WVA's <u>Health Insurers and Third-Party Administrators Compliance Guide</u> contains a checklist of items to ensure compliance with the WVA's requirements.
