

COVID-19 Assessment Grid Update

Dear Childhood Vaccine Program (CVP) Provider,

Please note that there has been an update to the 2025-26 WVA Assessment Grid (the "Grid") regarding COVID-19 vaccines. An additional COVID-19 vaccine for Nuvaxovid™ has been added to the Grid since last week's notification date October 9, 2025. It should be added to payer and provider fee schedules.

Effective for dates of services between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026 Nuvaxovid™ has been added to the 2025-26 WVA <u>Vaccine Assessment Grid</u> (the "Grid").

Reminders:

- The current WVA <u>Vaccine Assessment Grid</u> is in effect between July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, and it is posted to the WVA's website in both PDF and Excel format.
- The *Grid* lists vaccines and their corresponding CPT codes that are part of the dosage-based assessment (DBA) process for providers, health insurance carriers, and third-party administrators (TPAs). In effect, the *Grid* is the equivalent to a fee schedule. **Providers are required to submit the DBA at the** *Grid* **amount.**
- The WVA's <u>Private Insurance Assessment Billing Provider Guide</u> contains a checklist of items to ensure compliance with the WVA's requirements.
